

- Field Director Okon Obot reported that a leader of Open Bible Churches in **Nigeria**, Elder Monday, suddenly died. After being in the morgue for three hours, his wife discovered his eyes were blinking. Elder Monday now testifies of God's miraculous healing.
- Executive Director *Vince McCarty* traveled to **Taiwan** to visit with churches interested in affiliating with Open Bible and in the **INSTE** program. Most of these churches have outreaches into mainland China.
- The Open Bible Faith Fellowship church in Windsor, **Canada**, received a large gift to begin building a facility for ministry to girls with life-controlling problems.
- A large, two-day outreach sponsored by several Tijuana, California, pastors and in cooperation with pastors in **Tijuana, Mexico**, was held in a Tijuana park. Practical ministries (e.g., health clinic, hair cutting) along with fun, games, and prizes were included with an evangelistic message; 250 people gave their hearts to the Lord.
- At a youth camp in Achina, **Ghana**, 15 people were saved and 50 people received the baptism of the Holy Spirit.
- A new church was built in Chwele, **Kenya**; 39 people were saved in one evangelism outreach in that area.
- Field Director David Moreno in **Cuba** reported that in five months of 2009, 1,070 people received Christ, several were healed, and many were baptized in the Holy Spirit.
- A group of five young men are students of a pilot pastors' training school at the church in Quezon City, the **Philippines**. In addition to INSTE and other Bible studies, they hold evangelism outreaches. In two outreaches 75 people accepted Jesus as Savior.
- At the Laini Mawe Open Bible Church in **Kenya**, 108 people received Christ as their personal Savior and 69 of them were baptized in water.
- Missionaries *Nelson and Tirsia Gaitan* in **Nicaragua** rejoice for the Holy Spirit's blessing on the visits of Pastors Terry and Trina Reilley (Martinez, California) and Pastor Jorge Urrea (Miami, Florida). They rejoice for the 30 people who were baptized in 2009.
- Four **INSTE** students were filled with the Holy Spirit in **Hungary** during class.
- Thirteen people were baptized in water and 14 people gave their lives to the Lord during the opening celebration of the church facility in Karawere, **Papua New Guinea**.
- Twenty groups, comprised of 328 people, visited the Puente de Amistad ministry base in **Tijuana, Mexico**, in 2009; because of their ministry, 300 people accepted Christ, 10 houses were built, people were touched through VBS, construction projects, dramas, outreaches at orphanages, feeding kitchens, parks, hospice visits, and other venues.
- Praise the Lord for the generous giving by women of Open Bible who each year give through **Women's Ministries** to educate missionary children, to assist with the medical insurance deductibles, and to assist each missionary with funds toward clothing needs.
- The church at Buchanan, **Liberia**, destroyed in the civil war, was rebuilt with funds from Bethel Open Bible Church, Lodi, California.
- The \$23,293 received in the **2009 International Relief Offering** will assist orphanages and feeding kitchens in several countries.
