Among them was a young woman (right) who was delivered from a mental illness, accepted Jesus and was baptized in water! Praise the Lord!



Janet Rose, who attends the Open Bible Church in Congo Town, **Sierra Leone**, thanks the Lord for her healthy baby girl, Emilia (left). "Since I started coming to church, God has been so real to me.... The doctor said it was impossible for me to have another baby but Pastor Milton Godwin prayed for me and I got pregnant.... However, I had gone far past my due date and I was told

it would be very difficult to give birth without an operation. The first Sunday of the month is communion and because I couldn't go to church, the pastor and some members of the church came and gave me communion and prayed with me. That night I went into labor; in two hours I gave birth to a bouncing baby girl.... I am a happy woman."

Musu (right), an expectant mom, gave her heart to the Lord last month at the Open Bible church in Kalawa Town, **Sierra Leone**. Members of the church prayed for her and she safely delivered a baby girl, Sarah. Pastor Milton Godwin and other church members went to the naming ceremony. Four people who came to witness the ceremony gave their lives to Christ! Sarah was dedicated at the church last Sunday.
