#### Founding and Lead Pastor

2006 - Present

Life Church | Concord, CA

- → Planted Life Church in 2007, which began with a core group of 10 people and grew to nearly 300 in average weekly attendance with 2 service times, seeing hundreds of decisions for Christ with 12-15 baptisms per year
- $\rightarrow$  Lead a staff team including 5 Licenced Ministers as well as other ministry leaders
- → Raised and released multiple leaders and pastors into leadership positions in Life Church and other churches.
- → Helped plant and sponser Urban Life Church in Chula Vista, CA.
- → Helping prepare a church plant that is targeted to launch in 2026
- → Invested in nearly 30 interns to help give emerging leaders practical, hands-on local church ministry experience and opportunities
- → Renovated the 17 buildings on our 10-acre campus
- → Completely remodeled and updated our Worship Center
- → Paid off our \$250,000 loan for renovations in just 5 years (7 years prior to the deadline)
- → Adopted King's Valley Christian School as an outreach ministry of Life Church, which was on a path to closure
- → Since taking on leadership in 2006, enrollment has grown 65% and the school is financially sound
- → Grown church and school budget from 1.5M to 4M annually, reserves from 335K to 2M, employees from 37 to 65

- → Started the Youth Ministry, building identity, discipleship, and outreach from the ground up
- → First Full-Time Youth Pastor at Word of Life
- → Spearheaded a community outreach called "Extreme Summer" in the summer following the Columbine tragedy and saw over 500 teens make decisions for Christ with 40 water baptisms
- → Led Family Ministries
- → Developed and Directed Care Ministry, Pastoral Care, and Deacons Ministry
- → Developed New Believers follow-up and assimilation strategy
- → Oversaw New Members and Baptism
- → Partnered with a team to launch a new preschool
- → Saw church triple in size from 600 to 1,800 in attendance

- → Led discipleship, Ministry Outreach, and Missions Trips in addition to responsibilities as Youth Pastor
